Tips







Talk through their current fears and anxieties and discuss what can be done realistically.



explain that doing one's best is what really counts. Make your child feel comfortable and confident about the Assessment.



Prepare your child for the activity. Orient him/her on the Assessment Procedures.

Prepare Ahead



Please wake up early and make sure to eat your meals before your assessment. Please be there 5 minutes before the assessment. Assessment time is approximately 30 to 45 minutes.



Follow the schedule we provided in your email. If you join late on the scheduled date, you will be given a new assessment schedule. Requests for reschedule will be accommodated once only.

Materials Needed



Make sure to **prepare the materials** needed during the assessment: **laptop** (or tablet), **whiteboard** and **marker**.




You will need your **earphones** and your **laptop** when taking the assessment. All microphones and cameras should always be turned on during the assessment.

Materials Needed



Ensure you will have a **stable**, **uninterrupted internet connection** for your assessment. Have a back-up data connection (mobile data) in case your primary internet source fails.

Confidentiality



The assessment is **confidential**. It cannot be copied, printed, saved, recorded, or reproduced in any manner, at any time. The assessment should not be disclosed or disseminated to anyone before, during, or after the assessment.

Environment



Since they are expected to turn their mics and cameras on, please make sure that your child's study area is **FREE FROM UNNECESSARY NOISE AND VIRTUAL DISTRACTIONS**.



It is ideal that they work against a wall for a virtually **clean background and a quiet** space so that the class won't be interrupted when they take the test.

Parents Assistance



Parents and Guardians are to be on standby to help the child in times of Technical **Difficulties**. We are training our students to be independent test-takers so please let them answer their test on their own. For Kindergarten and Grade 1, teachers read through test items and they take the test together. For Grades 2-6, students answer the test on their own but the teacher is always ready to answer queries from the students.

Applicant must be able to

for <u>Kinder</u>

- write his/her full name
- identify upper and lower case letters
- discriminate letter sounds
- recognize and count numbers 1-10
- hold the pencil/marker properly
- follow given instructions
- express his/her needs to the teacher

for Grade 1

- write his/her full name
- identify upper and lower case letters
- discriminate beginning and ending sounds
- recognize numbers until 100
- add numbers with sum of 20 or less
- subtract numbers with difference of 20 or less
- read cvc words
- hold the pencil/marker properly
- follow given instructions
- express his/her needs to the teacher
